# The Text

- **Isaiah 50:6** I gave My back to those who struck Me. And My cheeks to those who plucked out the beard: I did not hide My face from shame and spitting.
- **Matthew 26:67** Then they spit in His face and beat Him; and others struck Him with points of their hands.

# Background of Isaiah

- Chapters 1 – 39 are called books of Judgment by some writers
- Chapters 40 – 66 are called books of consolation by other writers
- Chapter 1 – address the sins of Israel (North)
- Chapter 2 – 5 address the sins of Judah (South)
- Chapter 6 – Details the “call” of Isaiah as a Prophet
- - The same year King Uzziah dies, Isaiah see the throne room of heaven and the Lord High and Lifted Up
- - He see 6 seraphims
- - One approaches Isaiah crying Holy, Holy, Holy...

## 1. When You Understand You Go

- Vs. 8 – I heard the voice Of the Lord saying to me. Whom shall I send, and Who will go for us? Then Said I, Here am I; send me.



# Isaiah 6:11

## 2. When You Understand You Stay Gone...

- Vs. 11 Then said I, Lord, how long? And he said, Until the cities be wasted Without inhabitant, and The houses without man And the land be utterly desolate

## Ephesians 6:12

- **Matthew 27:67** Then they spat in His face and beat Him; and others struck Him with the palms of their hands.
